

BAND CAMP 2020 REVISION (July 14, 2020)

We know that we have amazing kids and our first priority is safety while giving the kids an opportunity to have band camp.

Friday, July 24 – Leadership Training (18 students)

Location: Band Room

Group A: 9:00am-12:00pm.

Group B: 1:00pm-4:00pm

Both groups will maintain a (9-1) student/teacher ratio and social distancing throughout the instruction. (Phase 2, indoors). Different chairs for each group.

Band Camp Zoom Meeting: Sunday, July 26, 2020, 7-9:00pm. Link provided on Google Classroom and BBOP website.

The purpose of this meeting will be to cover Rules, Forms and Expectations for camp. Introduction of staff and parent volunteers/nurses, as well as procedures for the specifics. (example: instrument and music distribution). If time permits, presentation of drill/music. This is for students and parents.

Daily Procedures: All staff/parent volunteers will have temp/symptoms checked prior to student arrival. All staff/parent volunteers will wear PPE while working the camp. Location: Bus drop-off area-north side end of the long sidewalk (7:30AM)

Arrival: All students/parent volunteers and staff are to park in the lot behind the administration building and proceed to the check in tables located at the end of the long sidewalk (bus drop-off area). Students will maintain social distancing & wear masks and proceed in single file lines where they will have their temp/symptoms checklist completed by certificated staff members. We will have two separate lines to help things move along. One line for wind players and the other line for guard/percussion. BBOP will assist.

During Camp: Students are to wear masks at all times unless actively engaged in the activity of playing music. Students must have all forms completed prior to participation in camp. Signed Waiver/Indemnification form, Band Camp Rules/Covid Guidelines form and Medical Forms. A signed hard copy of the Waiver and COVID Rules signature page must be brought with the student at check in. The student will not be allowed to attend camp without these forms or any online forms. The nurse will collect any medication from the students.

Students will also need to bring their own masks, water bottles, sunscreen, bug spray, hats and wear athletic shoes. Masks will be provided if someone does not have one. All students will carry their own equipment including their instrument, guard flag, music, sticks, etc. to and from the camp. No group storing or sharing/carrying of equipment.

Once students have completed the above, they will proceed, while maintaining social distance to the outdoor food drop off location and receive a bagged breakfast. BBOP will wear gloves/masks to distribute breakfast and assist in maintaining social distancing. Once they receive their breakfast, they will then report to their respective staff member. Each staff member will have a designated location for their pod of students to meet. All students are to maintain social distancing at all times. If students are not following safety protocols, they will be sent home.

July 27 – July 31- Full Band Camp Instruction 8-6pm. (87 Students)

Location(s):

Guard - Aux Gym/Outside of Aux Gym in Grass

Percussion - Grass area around band trailer

Sousaphones - Outside South House entrance (Berwyn)

Low Brass - Outside School Main entrance

High Brass - Bleachers in Stadium

Saxophones - Behind Administration Building

Clarinets - Varsity Baseball Field (down the hill from the visitor side of the stadium)

Flutes - Underneath Bleacher Home Side

Horns - Scoreboard

9:00-10:15: Brass & Percussion rehearse on the field in the stadium
(All students will have a designated spot on the field)
Woodwinds/Guard in small group sectionals (15 or less)
All sectionals will meet outside except guard in the aux gym/outside aux gym in grass area

10:30: bottled water break

10:45 - 12:00: Woodwinds/Guard rehearse on the field in the stadium
Brass/Percussion in small group sectionals (15 or less) outside

Lunch (Same as breakfast procedure)

12:00: Woodwinds/Guard pre-packaged lunch distribution (socially distanced)
12:30: Brass/Percussion pre-packaged lunch distribution (socially distanced)
All students will remain in their groups with their instructor during lunch.

1:00- 2:15 Woodwinds/Guard on the field in the stadium
1:30-2:45: Brass/Percussion small group sectionals/checkoff

2:30- 3:45: Woodwind/Guard sectionals
3:45: bottled water/snack break distributed by BBOP

3:00- 4:15: Brass/Percussion on the field in the stadium
4:15: bottled water/snack break distributed by BBOP

4:30- 5:45: (Full Group on the field in the stadium)

- Socially Distanced (All students at a 4 step interval = 7.5 feet both vertically and horizontally).
- Will include drill instruction
- Wednesday & Thursday team building with social distancing (drilldown & section song/rap)

5:45- Awards on the field in the stadium

6:00- Staggered dismissal (Staff, parents & drum majors assist)

- 6:00 - Percussion
- 6:10 - Guard (take flags with them)
- 6:20 - Brass (high brass/trombones take instruments with them)
- 6:30 - Woodwinds (take instruments with them)

- All percussion and sousaphones will be sterilized and placed on the trailer for overnight storage. Only one staff/parent will disinfect and load the trailer in order to maintain social distancing.

Pick up: Parents must be ready to **pick students up on time**. Dismissal will occur at the far end of the football stadium by Gate A. This will allow BBOP to help social distance students prior to pick-up. If your student drove or rides with a student that drives, they may leave together when they are ready to go.

Weather Considerations: In the case of inclement weather, rehearsals will be canceled. Communication will be given in advance if at all possible.
