What Is Band Camp?



- Band camp is a two-week session during the summer where students in the Bedford Bearcat Marching Band learn the music and marching techniques for the upcoming marching band season.
- Attending Band Camp is a requirement for all students in the Bedford High School band program.

Where is Band Camp This Year?



- This year Band Camp will be taking place at Bedford High School. The high school band room, other classrooms, and the stadium field will be utilized during band camp.
- COVID-19 safety protocols were taken into consideration when planning for this year's band camp. By hosting camp at BHS we are able to control more safety elements (cleaning, meals, social distancing).

When Is Band Camp This Year?



- Band Camp is typically the last two full weeks in July every year. This year Band Camp will take place:
 - <u>Week 1</u>: Monday, July 19th Friday, July 23rd
 (Friday, July 23rd is picture day)

• <u>Week 2</u>: Monday, July 26th - Friday, July 30th

What is the schedule each day of Band Camp?

- <u>Week 1</u>: Monday, July 19th--Friday, July 23rd
 - Color Guard 9:00am-3:00pm
 - Percussion 9:00am-12:00pm
 - Leadership training 4:00-6:00pm
 - Full band rehearsal 6:00-8:00pm
- <u>Week 2</u>: Monday, July 26th--Friday, July 30th
 - 8:00am Student arrival and light breakfast
 - 9:00am Field work/sectionals
 - 12:00pm Staggered lunch at BHS
 - 1:00pm Field work/sectionals/team building
 - 6:00pm Dismissal



Do I Have To Attend Every Day Of Band Camp?



- Yes! Students are required to attend every day of band camp. If a situation arises that conflicts with the band camp schedule, please communicate as soon as possible with Mr. Nichols and Ms. Shauf.
- All students will be required to stay on campus during band camp during the day (ex. no leaving during lunch/breaks). This is for safety/security reasons.

How Much Does Band Camp Cost?



- This year Band Camp will cost \$80.00. Payments can be made through check or money order (made payable to BBOP with student name included on the memo line), or credit card, Cash app, or Venmo through the BBOP website.
- Incoming students are required to pay an <u>additional</u> one-time payment of \$95, which covers the following items:
 - Marching uniform T-Shirt, shorts, and shoes (Dinkles)
 - 2 pairs of uniform socks
 - 1 BBMB drawstring bag
 - 1 BBMB water bottle
 - 1 BBMB knit hat
